✈️ IOSA Preparation Visit

// During this initial analysis of your documentation, we identify areas for improvement in the light of IOSA. This allows you to make the necessary corrections before the audit. ✈️ IOSA Initial

// The audit will be performed by a team of five specially trained IOSA auditors for a period of five days on-site. In an optional management briefing, we inform you about the latest regulatory developments, new IOSA standards and give you the opportunity to ask specific questions regarding your individual operational and organisational situation. 1 // Contact.

5 // IOSA On-site Audit.

We conduct the audit on-site at your premises. The renewal audit may take place 150 days prior to registration expiry date.

6 // Corrective Action Phase.

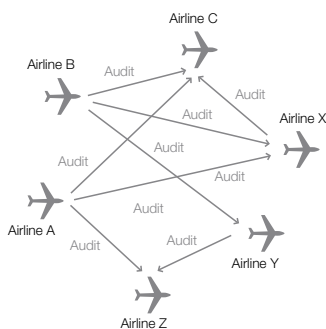
If applicable, findings must be closed within 12 months (initial audit) or prior to registration expiry date (renewal audit).

7 // IOSA Registration.

For an initial audit, IATA places your airline on the IOSA registry for a registration period of 24 months from the date of your initial audit closing meeting. For a renewal audit, IATA extends the validity of the registration for 24 months.
